If your meal plan runs out you can purchase additional meals in groups of 10 for \$65. During the last month of training meals can be purchased individually for \$6.50 per meal. Please be aware that meal plans expire at the end of each term. Meals do not carry over to the next term. Unused meals are non-refundable.

Payment information for the programs listed above: A \$25 nonrefundable application fee (not listed above) is due with each training application. A registration fee of \$100 is due within 30 days of the applicant receiving a letter of acceptance. The student pays 1/2 of tuition, student service fee, technology fee, book fee and security deposits on the first day of training. **Students must pay their dormitory fees for the entire term, at the beginning of each term. Fall term is from the start of the student's training program until Christmas break. Spring term is from the end of Christmas break until the student's graduation date or summer break, whichever comes first.**
